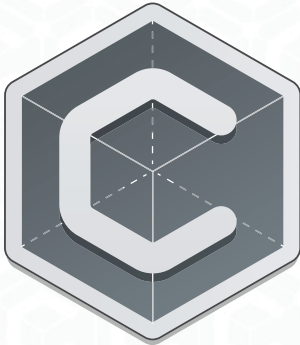

Special Characters

Special drafting symbols and characters are accessed from the keyboard. For a complete list of these characters see Appendix B in the User Guide.

Windows

Hold down the ALT key and type the desired numeric code:

Mark	Key Combination
°	ALT 0176
∅	ALT 0216
±	ALT 0177

Macintosh

Hold down the Option key and type next code combination:

Mark	Key Combination
°	OPTION+ SHIFT 8
∅	OPTION+ O (letter or number)
±	OPTION+SHIFT =

The following list includes common symbols which are available in all fonts.

Mark	Key Combination
é	OPTION + e then letter to be accented
è	OPTION + ` then letter to be accented
ñ	OPTION + n then letter to be accented
ü	OPTION + u then letter to be accented
